

ACTIVITIES YOU MAY NOTICE

- **Public space utility work between 14th and 15th on V St. in front of the school to be completed in July**
 - o This may require periodic closure and flagging on V St. between 14th and 15th St.
 - o This work will not block access to neighbor's houses
- **Parking will be restricted from 7am-5pm on both sides of V St per public space permits for utility work, for the length of the building property line**
- General increase in amount of activity on site
 - o Increase in the amount of deliveries
 - o Increase in the amount of construction workers
- Continued construction workers parking in the neighborhood subject to existing posted signage
 - o Construction workers will be restricted from parking on 15th St from W St. to V St.
- Continued servicing of the dumpsters

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Interior Renovation:

- Finishes and painting will conclude in the center renovation and additions.

Exterior Site Work:

- Site preparation continues for landscaping, concrete work, site retaining walls and the front staircase.
- Concrete pouring of the parking lot continues.
- Roof installation and exterior paint continues.
- Utility installation and storm water management will continue.
- Exterior brick façade work will continue on all exterior surfaces.
- Site preparation and equipment installation for the playground will begin.

Utility Work on V Street:

- There was a temporary water shut-off to tie in the new service for the school to the main line on V St. DC Water issued notices to those impacted 48 hours prior to shut off.
- Verizon will continue connecting their service to the new pole and will remove the old pole in the coming weeks.
- Washington Gas will also be connecting services to the school per their public space permit. This should not impact neighbor's services.
