

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Interior Renovation:

- Mechanical rough-ins continue and interior walls start to be closed in.

Exterior Site Work:

- Earth moving activity to prepare for the building structures continues.
- Concrete pouring for building foundations continues on the east-side.
- Structural steel being erected for the new additions on both the west and east-sides.
- Elevator pit and shaft construction continues.
- V St retaining wall construction begins.
- East-side retaining wall demolition is complete, which is the most disruptive work, and construction of the wall will begin.
- Utility installation and storm water management will continue.

Utility Pole on V Street:

- Verizon will soon be connecting their service to the new pole.
- Other service providers may also soon be connecting their service to the new pole.
