

## ACCEPTABLE DC PROOF OF RESIDENCY FAQs

### Q: WHY DO I NEED TO PROVE DC RESIDENCY?

All students enrolled in District of Columbia Public Schools and Public Charter Schools funded by the District of Columbia must provide proof of residency in the District, pursuant to relevant laws in place. If you have additional questions, please contact the DC Prep Enrollment Team (see phone number below).

### Q: HOW CAN I PROVE MY DC RESIDENCY?

To establish acceptable proof of DC residency, documentation must include the following elements:

1. An official document with the full legal name of Parent 1 or Parent 2;
2. An official document that states your current DC home address, as provided on DC Prep's Online Student Enrollment Form\*;
3. Parent 1 and/or Parent 2 (depending on whose name is listed in materials), should bring the document to the child's enrolling campus, in-person; and
4. Upon submission, you will sign a DC Residency Verification Form, in-person.

### Q: WHAT DOCUMENTS CAN I USE TO PROVE DC RESIDENCY?

Must be stamped by DC Office of Tax and Revenue.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Military Housing Orders</b> showing your name, current DC address, dated within the last 12 months.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>DC Ward Letter</b> proving the child is a ward of DC.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Embassy letter</b> showing your name, current DC address, dated within the last 12 months.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Unexpired DC Vehicle Registration</b> showing your name, current DC address, dated within the last 12 months.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Unexpired DC ID/Driver's License</b> showing your name, current DC address, dated within the last 12 months.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>Unexpired Lease or Rental Agreement and Receipt of rental payment for the last two (2) months</b> showing your name and current DC address.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> <b>One (1) utility bill with proof of payment</b>, dated within the last two (2) months.</li> </ul>
